We have four men in the church rotating on Sundays to preach and one of our deacons is teaching a home group on Wednesday evenings. It is exciting to see the livestreams each week and continue to hear/read the feedback from church families. One of the men in the church preached his first sermon a few weeks back and did an excellent job!

This is the goal for the church plant. We want it to be self-supporting, self-propagating, and self-governing. They continue to evangelise in the community and new people have started in our absence. God is good! We will continue to lead the church until God calls a pastor to take our place. Til then, we will continue to move forward reaching the community and sending out folks to reach other areas of the United Kingdom.

Continue to pray for the ministry in Scotland. Before we left for the states, we were making NBT visits and heard the testimony of a young boy (Calvin - 10) who was saved and God radically changed his life. His mum is a local witch and he has been fervently witnessing to her. She threw his Bible away, but he retrieved it from the trash and left it at a neighbours house to read each day. Oliver is 7 months old now. He is sitting up and eating big boy food. When he gets food, he looks at me, makes the "mmmmm" sounds and giggles. He is a smart kid.
